
Candide Upper STEM

Summary & Visual Lesson

Students were tasked with answering questions about their break and relating what they did back to Science, Technology, Engineering, Art or Math. Although at first some students had trouble making the connection they eventually figured out that we use STEM all the time in our daily life.


Material used was glue and construction paper/ felt



Ms A's STEAM Classes

Kindergarten, First, and Second grades finished up their Earth Science Unit on what makes soil projects, garden seeds, flowers/plants, trees discovery, and Genki Balls.

For the remainder of school year, students will be completing Ocean Science related projects beginning with what makes up sand, coral reefs, and Hawaiian fish studies.



This month, my students were inspired by the "Outside our mind" A.I. Creativity Art Contest through the Hawaii Cyberspace Academy. Fourth and fifth grade computer classes explored Artificial Intelligent (A.I.) created artworks using the website "Kidgeni.com".

Their work is different from our previous graphic design artworks because they didn't use shapes or even existing images to construct the artwork, but rather used an artificial intelligent computer program to create the work for them.

As a result all of their outcomes were new and original not lifted from the internet but generated by the A.I. through codes. In order to make sure that their prompts were safe to explore I asked my students questions about their favorite, colors, a place they wished to be at, how they felt when they thought about the future, a word in A.L.O.H.A (Akahai, Lokahi, 'Olui 'Olu, Ha'a Ha'a, and Ahonui (*Kindness, Harmony, Pleasantness, Humility, Patience*) and their favorite animal.

The students then took the responses to the questions, strung them together, creating a prompt to generate in "KidGeni.com". Their results were very unique from each other, very exciting, captivating and intriguing!
