- III. **Approve Minutes:** from February 14, 2022 (WebEx Virtual Meeting)

- IV. **Old Business:**
 - a) School Financial/Academic Plan updates will be included in Admin’s updates

- V. **New Business:**
 - a) Comprehensive Needs Assessment (CNA) has been reviewed.
 - i. There are only two recommendations that will be addressed at tomorrow’s ART meeting.
 - ii. Color- coded Academic Plan will also be modified at ART meeting.
 - iii. Feedback includes adding new SEL Panorama Data and Teacher Survey results.
 - iv. There is a new initiative called Healthy Habits, Healthy Schools that will be included in the Academic Plan.
- VI. **Committee Reports**
 - a) **Administration:**
 - i. TATP are opportunities for teachers with tenure to seek job placements. There will be openings for Grade K, SPED fully contained classroom, and Grade 5.
 - ii. Classes will be transitioning from virtual to in-person learning for enrichment the first time in two years. Teachers will be able to meet each week for articulation.
 - iii. A lunch schedule survey was sent out to the Jefferson Team to get input on returning to the cafeteria possibly in April.

1. **Teacher:** *Maria* discussed having a grade level teacher to be part of SCC next year. This teacher will be able to share more information. *Clara* recommended asking *Mrs. Quay* as a good choice. WIDA testing is done, goals met with some students transitioning back to the classroom and newer students being serviced. *Maria* can also use her class following Covid-19 guidelines.
2. **Classified Staff:**
Virginia shared that Keiki Fun Run will be held in the first week of April. The BEE Store has been up and running with all classes coming in once a quarter. SEL trait for the fourth quarter is Compassion in Action, which focuses on empathy and acts of kindness.
3. **Parent:**
Mr. Vilamu shared his thanks for the school updates. He is happy about the emphasis on health and well being and is confident that parents feel safe. CNA makes sure of better responsibilities at school.
4. **Student:**
Clara shared that the fifth graders are missing their student teachers that have left after last quarter. She enjoys reading time with *Mrs. Rose*. Even though mask mandates have been lifted for outdoors, most students are still wearing them. The Broadcast team is doing great, the Bee Store was fun, and Compassion in Action is the focus for the quarter. Fitness test scores came out today with healthy tips for students.
5. **Community:**
Grant shared that Moiliili Community Center (MCC) had a successful Spring Break program. There were 18 students, and 5 were from Jefferson. The MCC Summer Program will bus students who sign up from Jefferson to MCC for afternoon child care.
